TOP SAVINGS TIPS:

- 1 Install motion detectors and timers to control your lighting.
- 2 Upgrade to LED lighting.
- 3 Install timers on HVAC systems: Set thermostats to 24C in summer and 20C in winter.
- 4 Install timers and adjust temperature on display cabinets and fridges.
- 5 Review Tariffs and turn off appliance when not in use.
